INVITATION FOR PROPOSALS FOR THE SUPPLY, INSTALLATION AND SUPPORT OF SOFTWARE ASSET MANAGEMENT (SAM) TOOL FOR A PERIOD OF THREE (3) YEARS

Dube TradePort Corporation (DTPC) was created as a provincial public entity to develop Dube TradePort. Refer to www.dubetradeport.co.za for more information on DTPC.

DTPC intends to appoint a competent Service Provider that has a Microsoft Partner status to supply and install a Software Asset Management (SAM) tool that will allow DTPC to monitor and track Microsoft licenses and comply with Microsoft SPLA licensing requirements.

The purpose of this project is for the Service Provider to provide and install a Software Asset management (SAM) tool in order to create Microsoft SPLA license usage reports. The tool will be used to mitigate the risk of end customers installing Microsoft products and not reporting the usage to DTPC. The product should be customisable and include an automated inventory solution. It must show all installed Microsoft licensed software and include the access-authorised users on each SAL-based (Subscriber Access License) application such as Exchange, Office and RDP.

THE FOLLOWING PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA ARE APPLICABLE TO THIS TENDER:

- a) The SAM Software must have multiply resellers (or accredited support agents) that can supply and provide support of the software tool such that the tool is not only supported by one company.
- b) In line with the PPPFA regulations 2017 sub regulation 4, the prequalification for this bid is that:
 - (i) Only B-BBEE Level 1 or 2 companies are eligible to tender.
- c) A submitted bid that does not meet the above (a & b) requirement <u>will</u> be disqualified.

EVALUATION OF THIS BID

All proposals will be evaluated in various stages – compliance and functionality will be assessed and thereafter all responsive proposals will be evaluated in accordance with the PPPFA regulations, 2017 using the 80/20 preference points system.
